

## Friendship Pinwheel

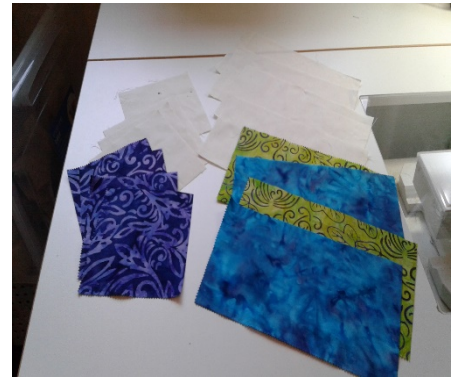

### Fabrics and Cuts needed

This block requires 2 medium fabrics, one dark fabric and cream

- 2 5 x 9.5 strips of each medium fabric (4 pieces)
- 4 5 inch squares of dark fabric
- 4 5 x 9.5 strips of the cream
- 4 5 inch squares of the cream



Using Dark 5 inch squares snowball one corner of all four medium pieces

There will be a large triangle, which can be saved as a  $\frac{1}{2}$  triangle, by sewing  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch snowball seam and cutting between the two seams

Sew a cream 5 x 9.5 piece to each snowballed medium color.



Snowball a cream 5 inch square to the bottom corner of the medium 5 x 9.5

Snowballing corners can be done by pressing the 5 inch triangle in half or by drawing a line and then sewing on the press or drawn line.

My preference is to mark my machine with a line directly out from the needle position. Place the corner of the snowball under the needle and align the opposite corner to follow the line as sewing.



Finish block by making a pinwheel out of dark points. This will create a 4-patch to sew together. Watch pinwheel point to get fabrics to nest together and create good points.
