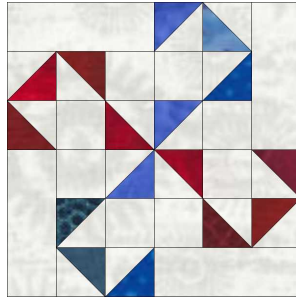


**Oklahoma Twister Block**  
**12 ½" x 12 ½" (unfinished) 12" x 12" (finished)**  
**July 2018**



**Color 1 – scrappy whites (background)**  
**Color 2 – scrappy blues**  
**Color 3 – scrappy reds**

**Cutting Instructions:**

**Color 1 – WHITE (background)**

Cut 4 rectangles 2 ½" x 6 ½"

Cut 8 squares 2 ½" x 2 ½"

Cut 8 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

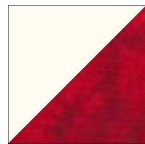
**Color 2 – Scrappy REDS**

Cut 4 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

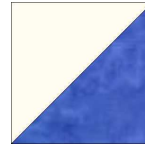
**Color 3 - Scrappy BLUES**

Cut 4 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

**Assembly:**



**Make 8**



**Make 8**



1. On the wrong side of all (8) 2 7/8" squares, draw one diagonal line
2. With right sides together, pair 1 red 2 7/8" square with 1 white 2 7/8" square.  
Using ¼ seam allowance, stitch on BOTH sides of the drawn diagonal line.  
Repeat with 3 more pairs
3. Cut the pairs apart on the drawn diagonal line.
4. Press the seam toward the red fabric.
5. You will have 8 red/white half-square triangles.

**Repeat steps 1 – 5 with the blue 2 7/8" squares and the rest of the white 2 7/8" squares.**  
**You should now have 16 half-square triangle units, 8 red and white, 8 blue and white**
