MEETINGS

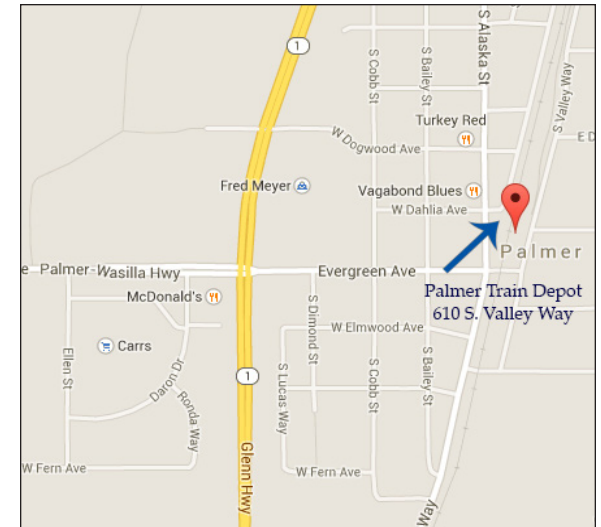
Valley Quilters Guild General Membership meetings are held at the Palmer Railroad Depot on the FIRST THURSDAY of EVERY MONTH at 7:00 pm with social time beginning at 6:30 pm, unless otherwise noted.
